These silly planters will entertain your kids as the hair grows out of egg heads.

What you need:

Eggs (brown eggs work best), craft paint or markers, cotton ball, grass or wheat seed

Instructions:

Crack and empty an egg. Wash the shell thoroughly and let dry. Paint a face with markers or acrylic craft paint. Place a water-soaked cotton ball in the bottom of the egg. Add grass or wheat seed. Place in a warm sunny spot. The seeds will sprout in two to three days. Trim to desired hair style.
