Supply list:

1. Shells (pack from Dollarama)
2. Styrofoam balls or pom poms (Dollarama)
3. Glue
4. Paint

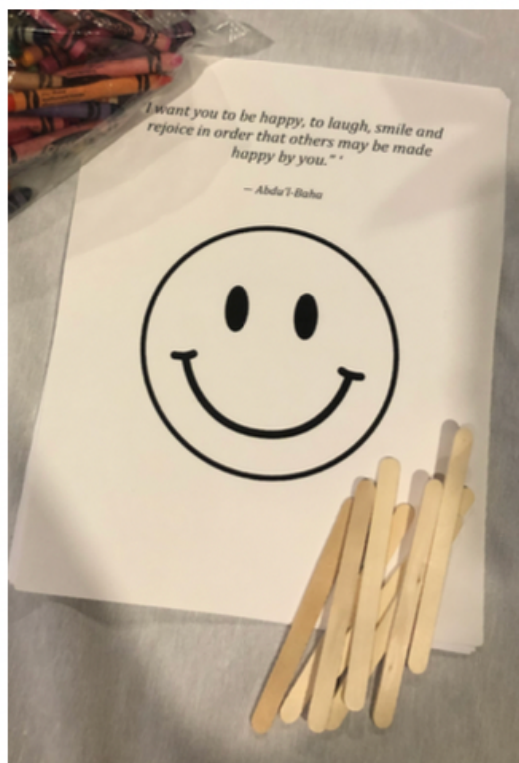
Instructions:

1. Let the children paint the outside of the shell
2. While it's drying you can learn the prayer
3. After it's dried, you can glue the pom pom or whatever you are using to look like a pearl inside.

Instructions:

1. Have the children color the smiley face
2. Cut out the smiley face and glue it onto a popsicle stick
3. They can hold it while they sing the song

Materials:

1. Printed paper with the smiley face
2. Popsicle sticks
3. Crayons or markers

Instructions:

1. Cut hole out of paper plate
2. Stick contact paper to the plate
3. Have the children add flowers (I used a flower bouquet that was about to wilt)
4. Write quote on the border of the paper plate
5. Hole punch and add string
6. Hang on window

1. Flowers
2. Paper plates
3. Contact paper
4. String
5. Hole puncher

Instructions:

1. Draw a few basic lines for the water and tree
2. Cut out ahead of time small pieces of tissue paper or have the kids cut them.

Supply list:

1. Paper to draw the outline
2. Tissue paper (blue for water, green for leaves and brown for tree trunk)
3. Glue
